

EASTER WEEKEND ARRIVES! HERE ARE SOME THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT AVALON IF YOU VISIT THIS WEEKEND!

Happy April, Avalon! If you visit us during this holiday weekend, here are a few tips for you! The Avalon Beach Tag booth at 30th Street and the beach will be open weekends, starting Saturday, April 3rd. You can pick up your Avalon beach tags for the summer of 2021; the preseason price is \$25 per tag. Avalon Community Hall remains closed to the public. The building has been used by the County of Cape May this year for a county-wide coronavirus vaccination site.

Outdoor recreation facilities are all open, including playgrounds at Surfside Park and at 39th Street and Dune Drive.

It will be a pleasant weekend to stroll the Avalon boardwalk. The rest rooms at Surfside Park on the boardwalk are open and maintained by the Avalon Department of Public Works for your convenience.

Select beach paths in the north end of Avalon, including those at 12th and 13th streets, are closed due to severe beach erosion in the area. They are closed for public safety concerns. Other beach paths remain open to the public. Avalon will conduct a sand back passing operation this spring to rebuild the beaches and beach baths in several blocks on the north end for your safety and convenience.

Construction on the Ingram's Thorofare Bridge (the high span bridge on Avalon Boulevard, maintained by the County) is ahead of schedule. A traffic control device for one lane of traffic remains in place. It is very likely both lanes will be open, weekends, later this month. Due to state executive orders that regulate/limit outdoor gatherings, the annual Easter Egg Hunt will not be held this weekend.

The Avalon Free Public Library and the Avalon History Center continue with exciting programs. Visit [avalonfreelibrary.org](http://avalonfreelibrary.org) for a schedule of virtual events. The Library will be closed Sunday in observance of the Easter holiday.
