EXECUTIVE ORDER OF THE MAYOR
ORDER No. 2020-19

EXECUTIVE ORDER AMENDING THE BOROUGH’S TERP (TEMPORARY EMERGENCY RECOVERY PLAN) AND EXTENDING THE TERMINATION THEREOF UNTIL NOVEMBER 30, 2020 AND PROHIBITING THE USE OF CERTAIN HEATING DEVICES IN THE BOROUGH RIGHT-OF-WAY (“ROW”)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Governor Murphy’s Executive Order 183 (“Murphy EO 183” issued on September 1, 2020 to be effective as of September 4, 2020 at 6:00 AM and the protocols issued by the New Jersey Department of Health (“NJDOH”), the Borough of Avalon’s Temporary Emergency Recovery Plan (“TERP”) is amended as set forth in Amendment No. 1; and

WHEREAS, Amendment No.1 became effective on the same date and time as Murphy EO 183 and this Mayoral Executive Order (“MEO”) is intended to ratify and confirm such actions which have been sanctioned in the interim; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I HEREBY ORDER AND DIRECT THE FOLLOWING:

- 1.** The Borough’s *TEMPORARY EMERGENCY RECOVERY PLAN* (“TERP”) is amended in accordance with Amendment No. 1 dated September 1, 2020 and implemented in the Borough effective September 4, 2020 at 6:00 AM, which is on file with the Borough Clerk.

2. The TERP, originally scheduled to expire on October 31, 2020, is hereby extended and will now expire on November 30, 2020 at midnight.

HEATING DEVICES:

3. The use of any portable heating device of any type which is designed to operate on any type fuel or electricity, within the ROW is strictly prohibited. The use of any such device shall be restricted to that area of outdoor dining that is within the deeded property only and provided, further, that the use of such devices shall be in accordance with the New Jersey Fire Code or the New Jersey Uniform Construction Code (UCC) or both and shall be subject to the approval of the Borough Fire Official or Construction Official.

EFFECTIVE DATE; AMENDMENT TO MEO 2020-9

4. This Mayoral Executive Order (“MEO”) is intended to conform the Borough’s TERP to Murphy’s EO 183 and the Amendment shall be deemed effective as of September 4, 2020 at 6:00 AM and any actions undertaken by Borough Officers or Personnel in furtherance of or pursuant to Murphy’s EO 183 is ratified and approved.

5. Section 3 of MEO 2020-9 issued on May 26, 2020 is hereby amended to the extent required to conform with this MEO.
